***I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst. (John 6:35)***

Sometimes we find it difficult to deal with people who have selfish motives to come to Christ. Jesus had to encounter their selfishness and shallow understandings.

**1. Focus of the worldly (John 6:24-27)** – While Jesus was planning eternity for such people they were interested only in the carnal things of the world. When we make only material things our focus, we cannot understand the plan of God for our lives. This is the root cause of every problem in churches. More than on spiritual blessings we are concerned about worldly things.

**2. God is the source of every blessing (John 6:28-32)** – Christ told the crowd that the manna they ate was sent by God. The problem with believers is that we get so busy and immersed in our blessings that we forget the one who blesses us. God blesses us with many things and in order to continue enjoying his blessings we need to accept him as the source of every blessing and make efforts to please him.

**3. True contentment is in Christ alone (John 6:33-35)** – While people were concerned only about the physical bread, Christ talked about manna that would satisfy their hunger for eternity. The one who is in Christ has no fear of money, property, fame or anything else. He is satisfied because Christ is with him.

Jesus is the bread of life. The one who feeds on him will remain healthy and spiritually active and will find a place in eternity.
